Athletic Training and Conduct Code

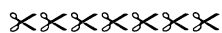
Athletic excellence requires the athlete to maintain high personal standards of health, conduct, and academics. According to Mukilteo District Policy a student/athlete **must maintain a 2.0 GPA and no failing grades in order to be eligible for athletics. WIAA also requires that 4 classes must have been passed the previous semester/trimester.**

Because the athlete wants to be a productive team member, bring only honor to themselves, their team, and their school, and because only a healthy mind and body will allow them to do so, **the athlete agrees to the following health and conduct rules:**

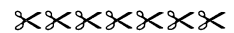
1. I will not use, possess, or sell tobacco products of any kind.
2. I will not use, possess or sell alcoholic beverages of any kind.
3. I will not use, possess or sell illegal narcotics or drugs of any kind.
4. I will treat my coach, teammates, officials and opposing team members with honesty, respect and courtesy.
5. I will make a sincere effort in my classes by being prepared, making an effort on assignments, and showing good citizenship around school.
6. I will abide by all school regulations as prescribed in the Mukilteo School District's Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook.
7. I will be at all scheduled practices for my school team unless excused by the coach.

Should the athlete not follow these rules, they will face the following disciplinary actions.

1. **For violations of the 2.0 GPA/no failing grade requirement**, the athlete will be placed "on probation" and may practice but not play in games until his/her grades are above a 2.0 GPA/passing all classes.
2. **A first violation of the drug, tobacco, or alcohol rules** will call for the athlete's immediate suspension from the team for the remainder of the season. If they attend drug or alcohol counseling, the suspension will be shortened to 20% of the regularly scheduled games.
3. **A second violation of the drug, tobacco, or alcohol rules** will result in the athlete's immediate suspension from all athletics for one calendar year.
4. **A third violation of the drug, tobacco, or alcohol rules** will result in the athlete being permanently ineligible for any and all athletic participation in Mukilteo School District.
4. **For violations of conduct rules** the coach may invoke penalties against the athlete. This may include loss of playing time or suspension from games.
5. An athlete "on probation" may practice but not play in games until such time as he/she can demonstrate satisfactory conduct.
6. The Principal, Assistant Principal, or Counselor may recommend "probation" if academics or behavior in class, activities, or school are not acceptable.
