## 2009-10 Olympic View Clubs and Intramural Activity Program (IM)

Dear OV Parents and Students;

The following is a sample of the types of *clubs & intramural activities* that we offer at OV for all 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students. We want all OV students to have the opportunity to get involved here at school. This year, our clubs will **meet on Mondays/Wednesdays**, while our Intramural Program will **run on Tuesdays/Thursdays**. Students will need to be picked up by a parent/guardian on time this year, as there are no longer activity buses offered to transport students home.

### Purchasing an ASB Card:

In order to ensure that we can offer clubs and activities to our students (as well as our 8th grade athletic teams), we require that all students who choose to participate purchase an ASB card for \$25. ASB cards can be purchased at any point in the school year from our bookkeeper in the office, or during our August registration.

**Supervision from 3-5 pm T/Th & 3-4 pm M/W in the Library:** With no activity buses this school year, we are offering students an opportunity to attend STUDY CLUB on Tuesdays/Thursdays from 3-5 pm and/or 4-5 pm in the library after activities or 3-4 pm on Monday/Wednesdays.
