Dear Parents,

Our students will be required to pass the 10th grade WASL and receive a Certificate of Mastery. As a result of these expectations, we will continue our efforts to prepare all of our students to reach proficiency levels in each of the WASL testing areas. It is reassuring to know that students who do not meet standard will have another opportunity in their Junior or Senior year to reach this goal. Students are allowed to retake this test to reach proficiency if they don't meet standard the first time.

There are many dates coming to OV in the next couple of months. I thought it might be best to communicate these dates with all of you now for your planning pleasure. **Please be cognizant of testing dates as these dates are critical for your student's success.** We are confident in how well prepared our students are for our state assessment.

WASL Schedule: All middle schools will be testing on the same dates. During the testing window, teachers will be aware of any additional assignments for students to complete. The testing dates are broken into grade levels for your convenience. This will allow you as a parent to know what test your student will be taking daily.

Please note: April 26th is take your child to work day. We are asking parents to keep their students in school on this day so students can participate in our state assessment. If this is inconvenient, we would appreciate for our students to be present in the morning so they do not miss WASL testing.

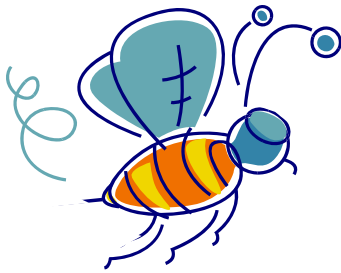

Notes from the School Nurse: Mrs. Fontes

Asthma, a chronic lung disease is one of the leading causes of illness related school absence. Approximately 9 million children under the age of 18 have been diagnosed with asthma. Asthma is characterized by acute episodes or attacks of breathing problems such as coughing, wheezing, chest tightness and/or shortness of breath. These symptoms are caused by airway swelling, blocked airways and increased responsiveness of the airways to a variety of stimuli or "triggers". Asthma can be controlled with proper diagnosis and management. **Effective management of asthma will allow a child to maintain a normal activity level and prevent acute symptoms and episodes.** If your child has Asthma type symptoms or is diagnosed with Asthma or Reactive Airway disease it is important for you to discuss management of symptoms with your doctor. **If medication is needed at school the doctor can complete a Medication Authorization Form for school.**



Olympic View Holds Spelling Bee Congratulations to the Participants

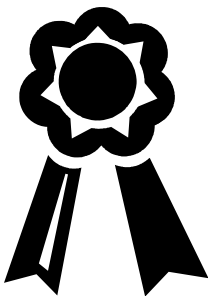
