Costume Guidelines:

1. Costumes are optional for , October 29th
2. All costumes must be **“school appropriate”**.
 - a. Not distracting to the school environment
 - b. Masks are not allowed. (Unless being worn as a part of a class activity i.e.: Health and Fitness Fashion Show)
 - c. NO blood and gore
 - d. NO Weapons
 - e. NO Racially discriminating costumes
 - f. NO Sexually explicit costumes
 - g. Questions surrounding **“school appropriate”**, please refer to your school handbook.
3. **Students who wear inappropriate costumes will be asked to change or will be sent home.**
4. All Costumes must be completely on when you come to school and all supplies are to be left at home (hair spray, make-up, etc.)

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

PE UNIFORMS AND LOCKERS

STUDENT DROP OFF/PICK UP
